This project develops partnership between Lajamanu Warlpiri Indigenous knowledge holders, anthropologists and community arts industry partner Tracks Dance Company. We investigate Milpirri Festival as arts innovation, engaging with community members in collective responsibility for Indigenous heritage and futurity. The project will generate new knowledge of Milpirri song, dance, art and story through practice-based research with benefits for industry partners and Lajamanu community of increased community participation, outreach and impact.
