Research study name: Justice Inclusion Access (JEINA) - Ecosystem of support for women students from forced migrant background

Researchers at UNSW are conducting a research study to understand current and emerging professional development needs of women in undergrad or post-grad study (including HDR) at UNSW who have experienced forced migration prior to settling in Australia. This is to help inform planning of a future program at UNSW. You are invited to participate if interested.

Participation in this research study is not a requirement of any course. Taking part in this project is optional and you may choose not to take part. Your decision to participate, or not, will have no impact on your course, assessments, grades or projects.

If you are interested, the research project is looking for students who are:

- Enrolled in an undergraduate or post-graduate degree (including HDR) at UNSW,
and
- Identify as woman,
and
- Experienced forced migration prior to settling in Australia. This includes those from refugee & Humanitarian visa backgrounds and exiles.

‘Forced migration’ refers to displacement that occurs when individuals are forced to leave their homes or places of habitual residence in order to avoid situations such as armed conflict, violence, human rights abuses, natural or man-made disasters.

This research study has 2 parts. You may choose to only participate in part 1.

- 1) Interview which will take approximately 1 hour. Interviews will be with investigators (Dr Parisa Glass, Dr Elnaz Irannezhad, Sherine Al Shallah) either in-person at UNSW Kensington campus or online via Teams.
- 2) Participants in part 1 will be given an option to undertake a [career coaching](#) program offered by UNSW Employability. Participants who complete this part will be invited to a second interview that will take approximately 30 minutes with investigators (Dr Parisa Glass, Dr Elnaz Irannezhad, Sherine Al Shallah) either in-person at UNSW Kensington Campus or online via Teams.
