

Progression into degrees




UNSW University Preparation Program students who successfully complete the program and meet the required WAM (Weighted Aggregate Mark) can apply for UNSW degrees in all faculties.

Students cannot use the UNSW Preparation Program as a qualification for entry into some degrees. Notably the Bachelor of Medical Studies/Doctor of Medicine and a Law degree.



UNSW University Preparation Program is recognised by a number of other universities.





Eligibility criteria



Australian or New Zealand citizen or Australian Permanent Resident, including Permanent resident Humanitarian Visa



ATAR of 50 or above, or applying via UNSW's Nura Gili Indigenous Admission Scheme




a. UNSW ACCESS Scheme via UAC's Educational Access Schemes (EAS) process


