Students must complete a total of 96 UOC:

- 12 UOC of Global Health (GH) Electives and
- 48 UOC of Core Courses and
- 24 UOC Extension component and
- 12 UOC any combination of GH Elective and Prescribed Electives

#The Extension component is either:

- 1) 6 UOC Research Methodology course and 18 UOC of Prescribed Electives, OR
- 2) 6-18 UOC Research Project with the remaining UOC as Prescribed Electives

*Extension components, GH and Prescribed Electives can be taken in any Term that they are offered. Students may replace up to 12 UOC of Prescribed Electives with an Independent study or Internship. Please check the eligibility requirements for an [Independent Study](#) or [Internship](#) before discussing with your Program Authority. Internships are offered in Terms 1 and 3 only.

*All School of Population Health postgraduate program students who completed their previous studies in a non-[English speaking country](#) are required to take [PHCM9100 Academic Practice](#) in their first term. The course is worth 0 units of credit, is not counted in your study load, and there are no tuition fees to be paid.
